**ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION**

For General, OBC – A, OBC – B & PH candidates:

✓ **54.5 % MARKS IN AGGREGATE & 54.5 % MARKS IN SUBJECT OPTED FOR HONS**  
**Or**

✓ **49.5 % MARKS IN AGGREGATE & 59.5 % MARKS IN SUBJECT OPTED FOR HONS**

For SC/ST candidates:

✓ **49.5 % MARKS IN AGGREGATE & 49.5 % MARKS IN SUBJECT OPTED FOR HONS**  
**Or**

✓ **44.5 % MARKS IN AGGREGATE & 59.5 % MARKS IN SUBJECT OPTED FOR HONS**

N.B.

- **AGGREGATE = MARKS OBTAINED IN ENGLISH + MARKS OBTAINED IN ANY OTHER BEST THREE SUBJECTS (EXCLUDING ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE/ STUDIES).**
- A deduction of 5% & 10% marks will be done from the aggregate for candidates passed out in 2013 & in 2012 respectively. Candidates passed out in or before 2011 will not be considered for admission.
- To be eligible for consideration of admission in Physics & Chemistry Honours having pass marks in Mathematics is mandatory.
- Eligibility criteria may change according to notification by Govt. of WB and/or NBU.

➤ **Calculation of Merit Point and Aggregate:**

Merit Point =  $(2S + T)/6$

Where T = Marks obtained by a candidate at the HS or equivalent examination in English + Marks obtained in the subject opted for Honours + best marks of any other two subjects (excluding the marks obtained in the ENVIRONMENTAL Studies/ Science/ Education and the subject opted for Honours).

S = Marks obtained in the subject opted for Honours.

Example: Say, a candidate has obtained the following marks in HS examination out of 100 in each subject and he/she has shown preference for Honours in Subject-I.

English	MIL/Lateen.	Subject-I	Subject-II	Subject-III	Subject-IV
65	68	85	80	62	71

His/ Her T =  $65 + 85 + (80 + 71) = 301$

His/Her **Merit Point** for Honours in Subject-I will be  $(301 + 85 \times 2)/6 = 471/6 = 78.5$

His/Her **Aggregate** will be =  $65 + 85 + 80 + 71 = 301$

N.B. A deduction of 5% & 10% marks will be done from the Merit Point for candidates passed out in 2013 & in 2012 respectively. Candidates passed out in or before 2011 will not be considered for admission.
