

## **DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMICS, REPORT 2025-26**

Activities of the Department of Economics for 2025-26 include Farewell Programme, Group Discussion, Wall Magazine and Class presentation.

This report summarizes four key activities conducted at the college in 2025-26 session, each designed to foster student development, creative expression, and community spirit.

### **1. Farewell Programme: "Cherishing Memories, Embracing the Future"**

The Department of Economics hosted a heartfelt farewell ceremony to bid adieu to the outgoing final-year students on 12<sup>th</sup> September, 2025.

Objectives: The event aimed to celebrate students' academic journeys, recognize their achievements, and provide a formal platform for emotional closure.

Key Highlights:

Cultural Performances: Juniors organised a series of activities, including Classical dance, Bollywood-themed dances.

Emotional Tributes: Video montages capturing memories from the first to final year were screened, followed by experience-sharing sessions by seniors.

Outcome: The event successfully strengthened the bond between juniors and seniors, leaving participants with lasting impressions and a sense of pride in the department.

### **2. Group Discussion (GD): Enhancing Critical Thinking**

As part of the academic curriculum, the department has been holding structured group discussions every year and as many as possible. A Group Discussion which was based on Union Budget 2026 was held on 9<sup>th</sup> February, 2026 at Room No 304.

Objective: This session was designed to move beyond rote learning, focusing on communication skills, teamwork, and leadership.

Outcome:

Confidence Building: Shy students were encouraged to articulate their ideas in a supportive environment.

Active Listening: Participants learned to respect diverse viewpoints and counter-arguments respectfully.

Career Readiness: The exercise prepared students for future job interviews and competitive exams.

### **3. Wall Magazine: A Platform for Creative Expression**

The Department of Economics had a Wall Magazine inauguration on 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2026 as a part of the monthly activity, showcasing the literary and artistic talents of the students.

Theme of the wall magazine: **Rupee depreciation and its impact on the Indian Economy; MSME is the backbone of the Indian Economy and Unemployment in India: myth vs reality.**

Content: The magazine featured diverse submissions, including data presentation, sketches, 3D paper arts on the theme and thought-provoking insights on the given topics.

Outcome:

Awareness: It successfully raised awareness about crucial Indian Economic issues among the students.

Collaboration: The project encouraged students to work together in researching, editing, and designing the display.

Recognition: It provided a forum for students who excel in non-academic creative fields.

#### **4. Presentation by SEC Semester I:**

On 24<sup>th</sup> November, 2025 a class presentation was held in the department of Economics by the SEC students on the different projects with the theme of tourism and tourism enterprise.

Objectives:

Knowledge Mastery: Demonstrating a deep understanding of course-level concepts and the ability to synthesize information from primary and secondary sources.

Skill Development: Building core competencies such as public speaking, audience engagement, and the knowledge of subject outside their core/major papers.

Analytical Thinking: Identifying relevant information and applying theoretical frameworks to solve problems or analyze scripts and data.

Outcomes:

Academic Retainment: Explaining a topic aloud helps students retain knowledge longer than passive reading.

Career Skills: Students gain knowledge, resilience, and composure essential for future job interviews and leadership roles and entrepreneur roles in tourism sector.
